

**HOPATCONG BOROUGH
ORDINANCE #10-2016**

**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FUNDING FOR PURCHASE OF
A PREOWNED VAN FOR ANIMAL CONTROL AND APPROPRIATING \$18,000
OF GENERAL CAPITAL FUND BALANCE FOR SUCH PURPOSE.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF
HOPATCONG, IN THE COUNTY OF SUSSEX AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The Borough of Hopatcong, in the County of Sussex, in the State of New Jersey, authorizes the purchase of a preowned Utility Van for the Borough of Hopatcong to be funded from the sources specified in Section 2 of the Ordinance.

Section 2. The amount of \$18,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Fund Balance for the purpose stated in Section 1 of the Ordinance.

Section 3. In connection with the purpose and the amount authorized in Sections 1 and 2 hereof, the Borough determines the purpose described in Section 1 hereof is not a Current Expense and is an improvement which the Borough of Hopatcong may lawfully make as a general improvement.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of their inconsistency.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon due passage and publication according to law.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the above entitled ordinance was approved on first reading at a meeting of the Governing Body of the Borough of Hopatcong held on March 16, 2016 at the Hopatcong Municipal Building at 111 River Styx Road, and that public hearing concerning same is to be held on April 6, 2016 at the Hopatcong Municipal Building at which time all persons both for and against shall be given the opportunity to be heard concerning the same.
